

Toby Manthey TAM Program Lead



2019 TAMP

- Two assets: NHS pavement and bridges
- Designed to meet requirements
- Risk/resilience confined to risk section

2022 TAMP:

- 12 asset classes: pavement, bridges, culverts, walls, buildings, tunnels, etc.
- Not just meeting requirements, but "how we do business"
- Risk integrated throughout
- · Modular, for splitting into FHWA draft vs. in-house draft
- Pavement forecasts predict National Performance Measure performance, not in-house metric
- "Collateral" to promote TAMP to Regions
